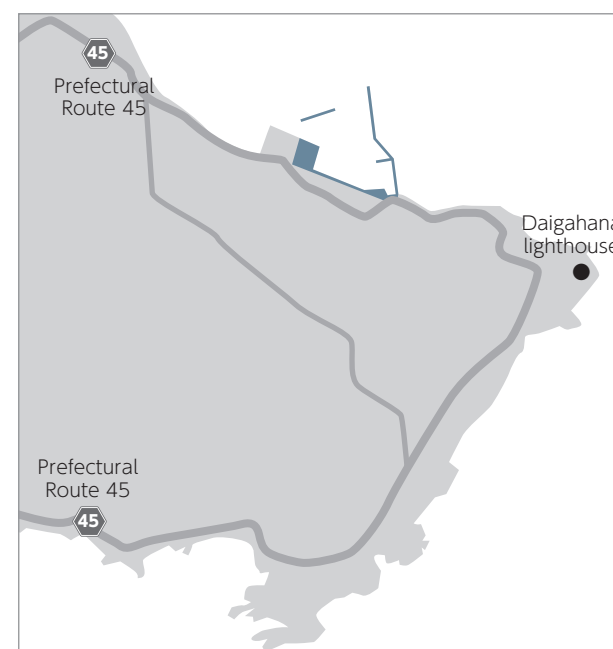

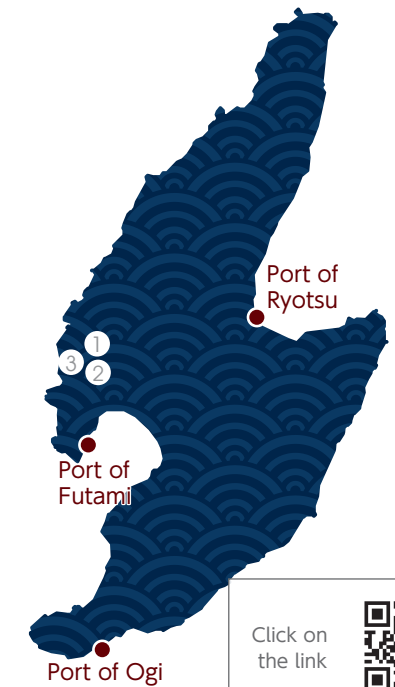

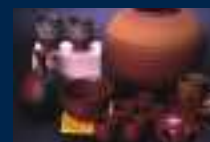


A Noh stage, which claims to be the origin of Sado's Noh performances.

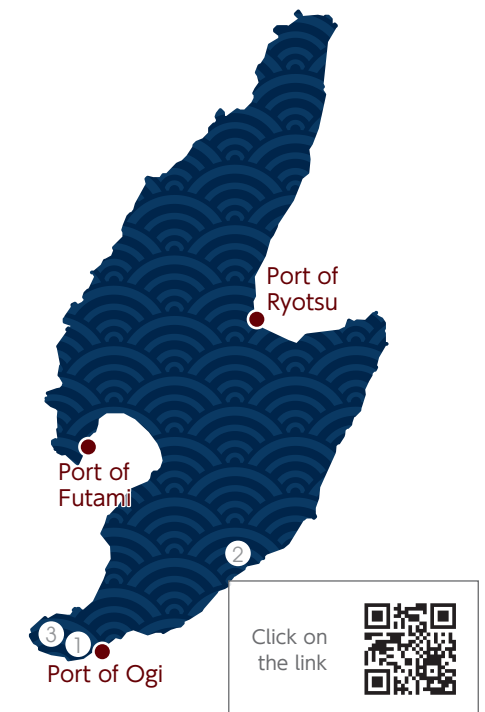

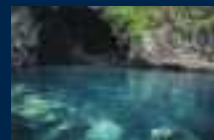

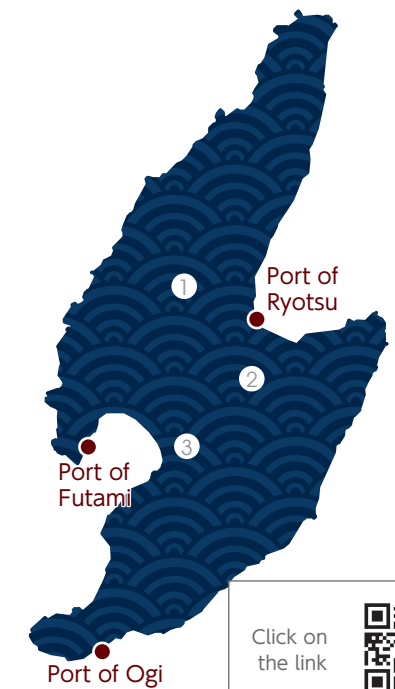
